Key Question

How can colleges and universities work with local schools to increase college going and college readiness in order to counteract the negative impact of Covid-19 and close longstanding gaps for students of color?



College Going: Conversation

- Differentiate supports for students based on where they are in their path to high school graduation and college going
- Improve the applications/admissions experience
- Increase the confidence of students and family that they can pay for college
- Increase peer and near peer supports for HS students
- Improve the effectiveness of communications campaigns



College Readiness: Conversation

- Evolve/expand current programs delivered by colleges and universities to help close increasing learning gaps
- Explore new models for partnerships between high schools and colleges/universities across school districts without regard to size or location
- Engage faculty across secondary and post-secondary sectors to map curriculum pathways to mitigate learning loss and accelerate college readiness
