

Regional Challenge Grant: Overview

Key Facts

- WSAC received 80 applications requesting a total of \$69.4 million
- Two tiers of grants will be awarded:
 - Tier 1 Partnership formation grants to entities focused on building new partnerships aimed at improving postsecondary attainment and career pathways:
 - 40 applications received; \$5.1 million requested
 - Applications spread widely across the state
 - Tier 2 Implementation grants to established partnerships that are ready to test new strategies, expand efforts, or scale up to support more students:
 - 40 applications received; \$64.3 million requested
 - Applications concentrated in King, Pierce, and the Olympic Peninsula
- WSAC has only \$5.5 million available for grant awards at this time
- In alignment with the Letter of Interest (LOI), evaluation criteria included:
 - o Authenticity of the regional partnership
 - Focus on equity
 - Strength of strategy
 - Resourcefulness of the partners
