

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RECEIPT OF PERSONAL PROTECTION EQUIPMENT (PPE) REQUIREMENTS

Hard Hat Tour
Rocky Reach Dam

You have signed up for an in depth, behind the scenes, hardhat tour at Rocky Reach Dam.

In order to participate in the tour, you are required to follow Rocky Reach Dam Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) requirements:

- **Long pants that cover the ankle (no skin can show)**
- **Shirt with sleeves; short sleeves are acceptable (sleeveless shirts not allowed)**
- **Shoe that covers entire foot (no clogs or sandals of any kind allowed, no skin from the foot can show)**
 - **tennis shoe**
 - **boot**
- **Must be at least 12 years of age on the date of the tour**
- **Be able to walk at least 1½ miles**
- **Be able to climb several flights of stairs**

Due to the electromagnetic fields located in the powerhouse, **you will not be able to take the tour if you have a pacemaker.**

There are no exceptions to the above PPE requirements. Any person not following the PPE requirements will not be able to participate in the tour due to the safety regulations.

By signing this form, the guest acknowledges receipt and understanding of the mandated PPE requirements and agrees to follow them for the duration of the tour. **The guest also accepts responsibility for any additional guests they register on their behalf and agrees to inform those guests of the regulations.**

PERSONAL PROTECTION EQUIPMENT (PPE) REQUIREMENTS

Chelan County PUD Hard Hat Tours

All persons who participate in the **in depth behind the scenes** hardhat tours at the Rocky Reach, Rock Island and/or Lake Chelan dams must meet the following requirements:

- Long pants required – no skin showing around the ankle
- T-shirts or long sleeved shirts are acceptable; no sleeveless shirts allowed.
- Enclosed footwear is required for the tour. Footwear must completely cover and protect the foot, no exposed skin from the foot. Approved footwear:
 - tennis shoes
 - work boot
- Must be able to walk at least 1-½ miles.
- Must be able to climb several flights of stairs.

Due to the electromagnetic fields located in the powerhouse, no guest with a pacemaker will be allowed on the tour.

There are **no exceptions** to the above PPE requirements. Any guest not following the PPE requirements cannot participate in the tour due to safety regulations.
